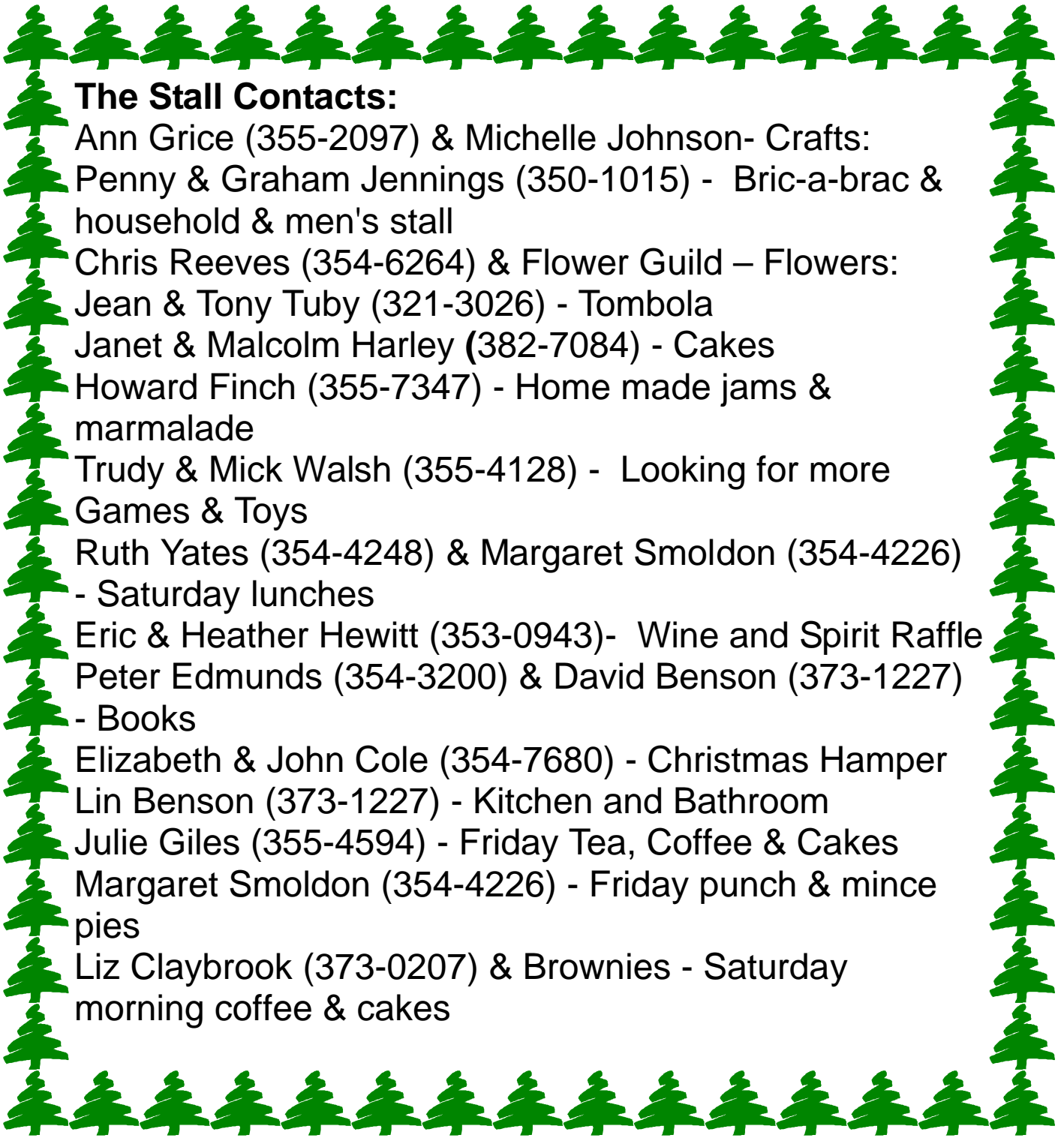
Many of the stall organisers names are listed over and they would be grateful for offers of help or items to sell.
